## Additional import duties on fruits and vegetables

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2023/2110</u> fixing the trigger volumes for the years 2024 and 2025 for the purposes of possible application of additional import duties on certain fruit and vegetables

## What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has established the conditions (quantities of imports) under which the European Commission may introduce additional import duties on certain fruit and vegetables in 2024 and 2025. This Regulation does not imply any intention to introduce such duties.

## Timeline

The Regulation applies from 1 January 2024 and expires on 30 June 2025.
