<u>Draft</u> Commission Implementing Regulation amending Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/632 as regards the lists of products of animal origin, animal by-products and composite products subject to official controls at border control posts

What is changing and why?

In order to avoid any ambiguity as regards which consignments of goods are subject to official controls at border control posts, the European Commission proposes to include the following CN codes when they contain product of animal origin:

- 1301 Colorant additive E904 including shellac of animal origin
- 2008 19 Nuts and other seeds
- 2106 90 55 Glucose and maltodextrine syrup.

Actions

Competent authorities of countries that are members of the World Trade Organization (WTO) can submit comments on the EU's proposal by emailing the <u>EU SPS Enquiry Point</u> until **28 November 2025**.

Timeline

The Regulation is expected to be published in January 2026, and will apply 20 days after its publication.
