What is changing and why?

So far in 2025, the following applications for registration as Protected Designations of Origin (PDOs) and Protected Geographical Indications (PGIs) in the geographical indications register of the European Union (EU) ([eAmbrosia](#)) have been made for the following.

Applications for registration as PDO:

- “Erzincan Tulum Peyniri”, a cheese mainly made from sheep’s milk in Türkiye (C/2025/500)
- “Aydın Çam Fıstığı”, a pine nut fruit from the tree *Pinus pinea* grown in Aydın province in Türkiye (C/2025/778)
- “Isparta Gülya”, an essential oil obtained from the Isparta rose (*Rosa damascena*) grown in the province of Isparta in Türkiye (C/2025/1382)
- “Kırkaç Kavunu”, a melon that grows in the District of Kırkaç of Manisa province in Türkiye (C/2025/1823)
- “Mut Zeytinyağı”, a natural extra virgin olive oil obtained from olives grown in the Mut Region in Türkiye (C/2025/2127).

Applications for registration as PGI:

- “Afyon Pastırması”, a dried meat product from cattle and Anatolian buffalo prepared with fenugreek in Afyonkarahisar province, Türkiye (C/2025/951)
- “Afyon Sucuğu”, a fermented meat product from minced Anatolian buffalo meat, beef, and tallow with various spices produced in Afyonkarahisar province, Türkiye (C/2025/1044)
- “Antep Fıstık Ezmesi”/ “Antep Fıstığı Ezmesi”/ “Gaziantep Fıstık Ezmesi”, a sweet spread made with pistachios from Gaziantep province, Türkiye (C/2025/1380).

Applications for Appellations of Origin and Geographical Indications:

Also in 2025, an application for the following product to be granted protection in the EU has been submitted to the [Lisbon System](#) of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO):

- “Vaj Ulliri Valmi Elbasan”, olive oil from the Elbasan area, Albania (C/2025/1846).

Actions

Objections to a name to be registered as geographical indication in the EU register ([eAmbrosia](#)) or in the international register ([Lisbon](#)) can be communicated to the European Commission respectively within 3 and 4 months from the date of publication of the application in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

Timeline

Opposition to registration as PDO and PGI of the names listed below may be lodged with the European Commission within **3 calendar months** from the indicated date.

Applications for registration as PDO:

- “Erzincan Tulum Peyniri” from Türkiye, from 24 January 2025
- “Aydın Çam Fıstığı” from Türkiye, from 31 January 2025
- “Isparta Gülya” from Türkiye, from 26 February 2025
- “Kırkaç Kavunu” from Türkiye, from 24 March 2025
- “Mut Zeytinyağı” from Türkiye, from 7 April 2025.

Applications for registration as PGI:

- “Aydın Pastırması” from Türkiye, from 6 February 2025
- “Aydın Sucu” from Türkiye, from 13 February 2025
- “Antep Fıstık Ezmesi”/ “Antep Fıstığı Ezmesi”/ “Gaziantep Fıstık Ezmesi” from Türkiye, from 26 February 2025.

Opposition to applications to the Lisbon System may be lodged within **4 calendar months** from the indicated date:

- “Vaj Ulliri Valmi Elbasan” from Albania, from 21 March 2025.
