## Approval of a health claim for green kiwifruit Hayward

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Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2025/1560</u> authorising a health claim made on foods, other than those referring to the reduction of disease risk and to children's development and health

## What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has approved the health claim that consumption of green kiwifruit (*Actinidia deliciosa* "Hayward") contributes to normal bowel function by increasing stool frequency. This health claim can only be used if accompanied by additional information stating that "the beneficial effect is obtained with a daily intake of 200 g of fresh green kiwi flesh".

## Timeline

The health claim is permitted from **20 August 2025**.
