# What is changing and why?

So far in 2025, the following Protected Designations of Origin (PDOs) and Protected Geographical Indications (PGIs) have been approved in the geographical indications register of the European Union (EU) (eAmbrosia):

#### PDOs:

- "Ayd■n Memecik Zeytini" from Türkiye
- "Gula Kelapa Kulonprogo Jogja" from Indonesia.

#### PGIs:

"Silifke Yo■urdu" from Türkiye.
