

# Authorisation: import of various genetically modified maizes

## Regulation

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2023/2133](#) of 13 October 2023 authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize MON 89034 × 1507 × MIR162 × NK603 × DAS-40278-9 and nine sub-combinations

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2023/2134](#) of 13 October 2023 authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize MON 87419

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2023/2143](#) of 13 October 2023 renewing the authorisation for placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize MIR162

## What is changing and why?

These Decisions allow non-EU countries to export to the EU the following genetically modified (GM) maize varieties or food/feed products containing these maizes: MON 89034 × 1507 × MIR162 × NK603 × DAS-40278-9 and nine sub-combinations; MON 87419; and MIR162.

These maize varieties cannot be cultivated in the EU, and any products of these maizes (except food/food ingredients) sent to the EU must be labelled “not for cultivation”. There are no safety or nutritional concerns associated with consuming these genetically modified maizes.

## Timeline

These Decisions apply for a period of 10 years.
