



Authorisation of genetically modified maizes: April 2025

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Commission Implementing Decision (EU) <u>2025/692</u> authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize MON 94804

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) <u>2025/694</u> authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize MON 95275

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) <u>2025/699</u> authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize DP910521

What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has authorised the sale of three genetically modified maizes (MON 94804, MON 95275, DP910521) to be used in in food, food ingredients, feed, and products for any other uses except for cultivation. This maize can only be sold in the EU (it may not be grown in the European Union).

Timeline

These authorisations are valid for a period of 10 years (until 10 April 2035).
