What is changing and why?

The EU has authorised the sale of genetically modified (GM) maize DP202216. It has also renewed the authorisation of GM maize MON 89034 × 1507 × NK603, and MON 89034 × 1507 × MON 88017 × 59122 and eight of its sub-combinations.

Timeline

These authorisations are valid for a period of 10 years.
