Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2024/1822](#) authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize DP915635

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2024/1826](#) authorising the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize DP23211

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2024/1828](#) renewing the authorisation for the placing on the market of feed containing, consisting of and of food and feed products produced from genetically modified maize MON 810

What is changing and why?

The European Union has authorised the sale on the EU market of products containing, consisting of, or produced from the following genetically modified organisms:

- genetically modified maize DP915635
- genetically modified maize DP23211.

In addition, the EU has also renewed the authorisation for products containing, consisting of, or produced from genetically modified maize MON 810 to be placed on the market.

All three authorisations concern the use of the genetically modified organisms in food, food ingredients, feed, and products for any other uses except for cultivation.

These maize varieties cannot be grown in the EU, and any of these maize products (except food/food ingredients) sent to the EU must be labelled “not for cultivation”. There are no safety or nutritional concerns associated with consuming these genetically modified maizes.

Timeline

These Decisions apply for a period of 10 years.
