Regulation (EU) <u>2023/1530</u> approving *Chrysanthemum cinerariaefolium* extract obtained with hydrocarbon solvents

Regulation (EU) <u>2023/1429</u> approving *Chrysanthemum cinerariaefolium* extract obtained with supercritical carbon dioxide

What is changing and why?

These Regulations approve the use of *Chrysanthemum cinerariaefolium* extract, obtained with hydrocarbon solvents or supercritical carbon dioxide, as an active substance in commercial biocidal products (such as insecticides, acaricides and products to control other arthropods). Biocide producers must comply with specific conditions regarding use of the active substance.

The main aim is to ensure the safe use of pyrethrum extract in biocidal products, for the benefit of users, the environment and consumers.

Actions

Manufacturers of biocidal products must collect the necessary data for their products developed with the newly approved active substance.

Timeline

Approval date scheduled for 1 February 2025.

Date of effect: 30 July 2023.
