

Composite products: Official controls

Delegated Regulation (EU) [2023/1674](#) on the inclusion of certain products in the list of composite products exempted from official controls at border control posts

What is changing and why?

Some shelf-stable composite products that pose a low risk to human and animal health will be exempt from official controls at border control posts, including:

- certain spreads and preparations for making beverages containing cocoa
- certain prepared foods obtained from cereals, and cereal products
- certain prepared foods obtained from rice
- certain chips and crisps
- miso containing fish soup stock
- soy sauce containing fish soup stock.
