Contaminants in food: clarification of certain maximum levels

Commission Regulation (EU) <u>2024/1756</u> amending and correcting Regulation (EU) 2023/915 on maximum levels for certain contaminants in food

What is changing and why?

The EU has clarified the rules set out in Regulation <u>2023/915</u> on maximum levels of certain contaminants, relating primarily to cereals, oats, and rice. The clarifications include rules on sampling and analysis; the point in the supply chain (processed or unprocessed materials) where maximum levels apply; and the meaning of the term "placed on the market for the final consumer".

Timeline

These amended rules apply from 16 July 2024.
