## What is changing and why?

The European Commission proposes to update the data requirements that need to be met for the approval of active substances used in pesticide products in the European Union (EU). These changes reflect the development of new approaches to risk assessment.

## **Actions**

Competent authorities of countries that are members of the World Trade Organization can submit comments on the EU's proposals to the <u>EU TBT Enquiry Point</u> until **30 November 2025**.

## **Timeline**

These Regulations are expected to be adopted in the second quarter of 2026.
