## **Detection of Trichinella in pork**

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2025/506</u> as regards the reference method and the authorisation of lumiVAST Trichinella as an equivalent method for detection of Trichinella in meat of domestic swine

## What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has amended its rules for testing pork for the parasite *Trichinella*. The changes include the following.

- Reference method: specification of the samples, including weights, to be taken in the case of whole carcasses and cuts of pork.
- New detection method: the "lumiVAST Trichinella" method is authorised under certain conditions as an alternative equivalent detection method.

## Timeline

The Regulation applies from 9 April 2025.
