## What is changing and why?

The European Commission has evaluated the performance of its <u>Feed Additives Regulation</u> to assess whether it still meets the needs of citizens, businesses, and public authorities. It also aims to identify possible burdens the Regulation may have created, as well as any legal inconsistencies or gaps.

## Actions

Non-EU countries producing feed additives, compound feed, and feed materials should check the <u>EU Register of Feed Additives</u> regularly to ensure they respect the conditions of use and the timelines.

## Timeline

A proposal for revised feed additive rules is expected in 2025.
