What is changing and why?

The European Commission proposes to ban the use of benzene-1,2-diol (FL No. 04.029) due to concerns about its genotoxicity.

Actions

Comments or concerns about potential impacts can be submitted via the <u>National SPS</u> notification authority of the country concerned to the <u>EU SPS Enquiry Point</u> until **2 July 2024**.

Companies that export food products containing these flavourings can look for alternative substances in the Food Flavourings Database.

Timeline

The removal of benzene-1,2-diol from the EU list is expected from approximately the fourth quarter 2024. Foods containing this substance exported before the Regulation applies may stay on the EU market until their use-by date.
