Food additives in foods for particular nutritional uses

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Commission Regulation (EU) 2025/2058 as regards foods intended for particular nutritional uses

What is changing and why?

The rules on foods intended for particular nutritional uses (infant formula, baby foods, foods for special medical purposes, meal replacements for weight loss) were replaced in 2013 by Regulation 609/2013.

Regulation <u>1333/2008</u> on food additives has now been updated to refer to Regulation 609/2013. This alignment requires changes to the names of some categories of foods, but these changes do not have an impact on the additives that may be used in foods for particular nutritional uses.

Timeline

This Regulation enters into force on 4 November 2025.
