Food additives: sorbic acid (E 200) and potassium sorbate (E 202)

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Commission Regulation (EU) <u>2025/2060</u> as regards the use of sorbic acid (E 200) and potassium sorbate (E 202) in non-heat-treated plant-based mousses

What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has approved the combined use of sorbic acid (E 200) and potassium sorbate (E 202) in non-heat-treated plant-based mousses. The EU has determined that additional dietary exposure to this additive through this new use is not liable to affect human health.

Timeline

The new use of sorbic acid-potassium sorbate is permitted from 4 November 2025.
