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Regulation (EU) [2025/352](#) as regards calcidiol monohydrate used in the manufacture of food supplements

What is changing and why?

Following the authorisation in 2024 of calcidiol monohydrate as a novel food ingredient, the EU has now authorised this substance as a source of vitamin D that may be used in food supplements.
