What is changing and why?

The European Commission proposes to update the procedures for setting standard import values that are used to set entry prices for 15 fruits and vegetables during certain periods of the year. It proposes to set these import values on a weekly rather than a daily basis, and to clarify the conditions under which additional import duties (tariffs) can be applied.

Actions

Timeline

The Commission intends to adopt the revised rules in the fourth quarter of 2025.
