What is changing and why?

For consistency and simplification, the European Union (EU) proposes to incorporate the rules for the poultrymeat and egg sectors from Regulation [1484/95](#) into Regulation [2023/2834](#), which also covers rice, cereals, sugar, and hops. It also proposes to publish the updated representative prices for poultrymeat and eggs online via the EU Customs Tariff ([TARIC](#)) database, instead of in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

The water/protein ratio for category B frozen beef is corrected from 3:2 to **3.2:1**.

Timeline

The new rules apply from **1 April 2026**.
