## Latest novel food authorisations – June 2024

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Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2024/1611</u> authorising the placing on the market of isomaltulose powder as a novel food

## What is changing and why?

The European Union has given its approval for the marketing of isomaltulose powder as a novel food ingredient. This powder can serve as a substitute for sucrose in a wide array of food products aimed at the general public. It cannot be used in infant formula. The authorisation follows an evaluation by the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) that confirmed its safety.

## Timeline

The novel foods may be placed on the market from 26 June 2024.
