## What is changing and why?

Following the authorisation of magnesium L-threonate as a novel food in 2024, the European Union (EU) proposes to authorise this substance as a source of magnesium that may be used in food supplements.

## **Actions**

Countries that are members of the World Trade Organization can submit comments on this proposal, via their <u>National TBT notification authority</u>, to the <u>EU TBT Enquiry Point</u> until **6 June 2025**.

## **Timeline**

The Regulation is expected to apply from late 2025/early 2026.
