What is changing and why?

Following the authorisation of magnesium L-threonate as a novel food in 2024, the European Union (EU) proposes to authorise this substance as a source of magnesium that may be used in food supplements.

Actions

Feedback on this proposal to the World Trade Organization closed on 6 June 2025.

Timeline

The Regulation is expected to apply from late 2025/early 2026.
