## EU raises MRL for clopyralid on honey and other apiculture products

Commission Regulation (EU) [2024/2612](#) of 7 October 2024 amending Annexes II, III and IV to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum residue levels for chitosan, clopyralid, difenoconazole, fat distillation residues, flonicamid, hydrolysed proteins, and lavandulyl senecioate in or on certain products

### Update

The EU has raised the maximum residue level (MRL) for clopyralid on honey and other apiculture products.

### Impacted products

Honey and other apiculture products

### What is changing?

The MRL for clopyralid in honey and other apiculture products has been raised from 0.05 to 0.15 mg/kg.

### Why?

Following an application to modify the MRL for clopyralid in honey and other apiculture products, [EFSA \(2024\)](#) concluded that all data requirements were met and the modifications were acceptable for consumer safety.

### Timeline

The new MRL applies from **28 October 2024**.
