Commission Regulation (EU) <u>2024/2612</u> as regards maximum residue levels for chitosan, clopyralid, difenoconazole, fat distillation residues, flonicamid, hydrolysed proteins, and lavandulyl senecioate in or on certain products

What is changing and why?

Following an application to modify the maximum residue level (MRL) for clopyralid in honey and other apiculture products, and a report by the European Food Safety Authority concluding this to be safe, the EU has raised the MRL for clopyralid in honey from 0.05 to 0.15 mg/kg.

Timeline

The new MRL applies from 28 October 2024.
