



Maximum residue level for hexythiazox

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Commission Regulation (EU) <u>2025/1305</u> as regards maximum residue levels for amidosulfuron, azoxystrobin, hexythiazox, isoxaben, picloram, propamocarb, sodium silver thiosulfate and tefluthrin in or on certain products

What is changing and why?

The EU has raised the maximum residue levels (MRLs) for hexythiazox on blackberries and raspberries from 0.01 to 3 mg/kg, following an import tolerance request from the USA. An evaluation by the European Food Safety Authority concluded that there are no risks to consumers at the proposed levels.

Timeline

The new MRLs apply from 23 July 2025.
