



## Maximum residue level for mepiquat

Regulation <u>2025/1164</u> as regards maximum residue levels for cyantraniliprole, cyflumetofen, deltamethrin, mefentrifluconazole, mepiquat and oxathiapiprolin in or on certain products

## What is changing and why?

The EU has raised the maximum residue level (MRL) for mepiquat on grapes from 0.02 mg/kg (the limit of determination, LOD) to 5 mg/kg, in line with the Codex Alimentarius MRL (CXL). (The LOD is the lowest level that can be detected using the most modern and reliable analytical methods.)

The EU aligns MRLs with CXLs where they are not considered to be a concern for consumer safety.

## **Timeline**

The new MRL applies from 6 July 2025.
