## Maximum residue levels for Metarhizium brunneum strain Ma 43

## What is changing and why?

The active substance *Metarhizium brunneum* strain Ma 43 will no longer have maximum residue levels (MRLs).

## Timeline

The current MRL of 0.01 mg/kg will no longer apply from 27 September 2023. From this date, there will be no MRLs for *M. brunneum* strain Ma 43.
