Maximum residue levels for potassium permanganate

Commission Regulation (EU) <u>2024/345</u> as regards maximum residue levels for desmedipham, etridiazole, flurtamone, profoxydim, difenacoum and potassium permanganate in or on certain products

What is changing and why?

The EU has set the maximum residue levels (MRLs) for potassium permanganate to the limit of determination (LOD, the lowest level that can be detected using the most modern and reliable analytical methods), for all products.

Actions

Suppliers of affected products should explore alternative solutions to their current use of potassium permanganate.

Timeline

The new MRLs will apply from **12 August 2024**.

Products exported before 12 August 2024 that comply with the old MRLs will not be removed from the EU market after 12 August, even if they do not comply with the new MRLs.
