

Maximum residue levels for quizalofop

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EU establishes MRL for quizalofop on caraway

Commission Regulation (EU) [2023/377](#) of 15 February 2023 amending Annexes II, III, IV and V to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum residue levels for benzalkonium chloride (BAC), chlorpropham, didecyldimethylammonium chloride (DDAC), flutriafol, metazachlor, nicotine, profenofos, quizalofop-P, sodium aluminium silicate, thiabendazole and triadimenol in or on certain products

Update

The European Commission has established an MRL of 0.04 mg/kg for quizalofop on caraway.

Impacted products

caraway

What is changing?

An MRL of 0.04 mg/kg is set for quizalofop on caraway, defined as the sum of quizalofop, its salts, its esters (including propaquizafop) and its conjugates, expressed as quizalofop (any ratio of constituent isomers).

Why?

Following a request and evaluation by [EFSA \(2021\)](#), the Commission has established an MRL for quizalofop on caraway.

Timeline

The new MRL for quizalofop will apply from 14 September 2023.
