Maximum residue levels on radish leaves

Commission Regulation (EU) 2024/3196 as regards radish leaves

What is changing and why?

Previously the maximum residue levels (MRLs) for radish leaves were the same as the MRLs for kale. This Regulation introduces a distinction between small and large radish leaves:

- large radish leaves: MRLs for kale apply
- small radish leaves: MRLs for Roman rocket/rucola apply.

Actions

The MRLs for kales and Roman rocket/rucola are not always the same. Exporters of **small** radish leaves should check if their products comply with the MRLs for Roman rocket/rucola. An overview of all EU MRLs can be found in the <u>EU Pesticide Residues database</u>.

Timeline

The MRLs for Roman rocket/rucola will apply to small radish leaves from 8 January 2025.
