MRL for fluralaner in fin fish

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2025/1908</u> as regards the classification of the substance fluralaner with respect to its maximum residue limit in foodstuffs of animal origin

What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has set a maximum residue limit (MRL) for fluralaner of 65 μ g/kg for Salmonidae and other fin fish, applicable to muscle and skin in natural proportions.

Timeline

The new MRL applies from 15 October 2025.
