Regulation (EU) <u>2023/2847</u> authorising the placing on the market of apple fruit cell culture biomass as a novel food

What is changing and why?

Based on an evaluation by the European Food Safety Authority, this Regulation permits this novel food to be marketed in the EU for use in food supplements for adults. It is subject to specific conditions of use and labelling requirements (including a statement that food supplements containing apple fruit cell culture biomass should only be consumed by persons over 18 years of age). Details of these conditions and labelling requirements are set out in the Annex to the Regulation.

Timeline

This product is permitted on the market from 9 January 2024.
