European Commission updates specification for the novel food Calanus finmarchicus oil

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2022/966</u> of 21 June 2022 amending Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2470 as regards the conditions of use, the specific labelling requirements and specifications of the novel food Calanus finmarchicus oil

### **Update**

The European Commission has updated the specifications (permitted use levels) of the novel food Calanus finmarchicus oil, increasing the maximum level of astaxanthin esters, and reducing the authorised use level.

## What is changing?

Calanus finmarchicus oil was originally authorised under Commission Implementing Decision (EU) <u>2017/2353</u>. The following changes to the specification have been requested and accepted by the Commission:

- increased maximum level of up to 0.25% of astaxanthin esters contained in Calanus finmarchicus oil for persons older than 14 years of age
- reduction in currently authorised use level of Calanus finmarchicus oil from 2.3 to 1.0 g/day, excluding infants and young children.

### **Timeline**

This amendment entered into force on 21 June 2022.
