

# Novel food: cellobiose

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## Regulation

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) [2023/943](#)

## What is changing and why?

The EU has authorised cellobiose as a novel food that may be placed on the EU market in a number of foods. These include food supplements, but not those to be used by infants and young children.

## Actions

Only the company that applied for the authorisation, SAVANNA Ingredients GmbH, is authorised to place this novel food on the EU market for a period of 5 years, unless another company obtains a novel food authorisation for cellobiose, or with the agreement of SAVANNA Ingredients GmbH.

## Timeline

These products are permitted on the EU market from 1 June 2023.
