## Novel food: Phosphated distarch phosphate

## What is changing and why?

The novel food "phosphated distarch phosphate produced from wheat starch" was authorised in May 2014. However, it was left off the EU list by mistake when the list was first established. This Regulation corrects that mistake and adds this wheat starch to the EU list of authorised novel foods.

## Timeline

Date of effect: 31 May 2023.
