Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) <u>2024/2684</u> as regards the protein-related requirements for infant and follow-on formula manufactured from protein hydrolysates

What is changing and why?

The European Commission has approved a specific protein hydrolysate derived from whey protein for use in infant formula and follow-on formula, following an evaluation by the European Food Safety Authority.

Timeline

The Regulation applies from 11 October 2024.
