#### Update

The European Commission has published a notice to assist national authorities and businesses to apply the EU rules on organic beekeeping. The notice answers questions received, mainly on implementation of the Organic Regulation (EU) <u>2018/848</u>.

#### Impacted products

Organic honey, organic beekeeping, beeswax

#### What is changing?

Answers are provided on:

- low environmental impact methods, location of apiaries, and husbandry practices
- possibilities for beeswax producers and processors to be certified as organic operators
- classification of beeswax
- natural products such as propolis, wax, and plant oils that may be used in hives.

#### Timeline

The notice was published on 25 April 2024.

### What are the major implications for exporting countries?

The Commission notice is not a binding document, it is intended to clarify implementation of the Organic Regulation.
