

# Reauthorisation of genetically modified maize T25

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) [2026/518](#) renewing the authorisation for placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified maize T25 (ACS-ZMØØ3-2)

## What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has reauthorised the sale of GM maize T25 to be used in food, food ingredients, feed, and products for any other uses except for cultivation. Within the EU, this maize can only be sold (it may not be grown).

The European Food Safety Authority has concluded that GM maize T25 is safe under the applicant's proposed conditions of use.

## Timeline

This authorisation is valid for a period of 10 years (until March 2036).
