What is changing and why?

The following have been entered in the EU geographical indications register (<u>eAmbrosia</u>) as no opposition has been received by the European Commission.

Protected Designations of Origin (PDO) for certain:

- peaches, peanuts, and polyfloral honey from Türkiye
- peppercorns from Indonesia.

Protected Appellations of Origin (PAO) for certain:

figs and olive oil from Tunisia.

These PDOs and PAOs are now granted protection in the EU.

Türkiye has applied for a **coffee substitute produced from seeds of terebinth or turpentine trees** to be entered in the EU geographical indications register (<u>eAmbrosia</u>).

Actions

Objections against a name to be entered in the EU geographical indications register (<u>eAmbrosia</u>) can be communicated to the European Commission within 3 months from the date of publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

Objections against protection within the territory of the European Union of a name registered in WIPO's <u>Lisbon</u> System can be communicated to the Commission within 4 months from the date of publication in the *Official Journal*.

Timeline

Date of effect:

- Appellation of Origin for Huile d'Olive Téboursouk: 25 July 2024
- Appellation of Origin for Figues de Djebba: 31 July 2024
- Registry of the name of peppercorns 'Lada Putih Muntok' (PDO): 25 July 2024
- Registry of the name of peanut 'Osmaniye Yer F■st■■ '(PDO) and polyfloral honey 'Bingöl Bal■' (PDO): 30 July 2024
- Registry of the name of peach 'Bursa ■eftalisi' (PDO): 4 August 2024.

Opposition against entry in eAmbrosia of the name 'Gaziantep Menengiç Kahvesi/ Gaziantep Melengiç Kahvesi' for a coffee substitute from Türkiye produced from seeds of terebinth or turpentine trees may be lodged with the Commission within 3 calendar months from 11 July 2024.
