Rejection of a health claim for isomaltulose

Commission Regulation (EU) 2024/2105 refusing to authorise a health claim made on foods

What is changing and why?

The EU has rejected a health claim for isomaltulose as a source of glucose, because the claim is conflicting and confusing to consumers. The health claim may have encouraged consumption of sugars, although it is generally accepted that consumers' intake of sugars should be reduced.
