What is changing and why?

The European Commission intends to reject a health claim that Joselito® ham has an effect on the reduction of LDL-cholesterol concentration or blood pressure. The European Food Safety Authority has concluded that a relationship cannot be established between the consumption of this ham and the effects claimed.

Actions

The World Trade Organization consultation on this proposal closed on 12 May 2025 (G/TBT/N/EU/1114).

Timeline

The Regulation is expected to be adopted in approximately the fourth quarter of 2025.
