Commission Implementing Regulation [2023/2660](#) renewing the approval of the active substance glyphosate in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council and amending Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 540/2011

What is changing and why?

After a scientific review by the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), which found that glyphosate is safe for use as a pesticide, the European Commission extended its approval for 10 years.

Actions

This decision has no impact on existing glyphosate MRLs and therefore no immediate implications for exporting countries.
