Renewed authorisation of certain GM oilseed rape varieties

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2024/389 renewing the authorisation for the placing on the market of products containing, consisting of or produced from genetically modified oilseed rape Ms8, Rf3 and Ms8 × Rf3

What is changing and why?

This Decision allows non-EU countries to export to the EU the following genetically modified (GM) oilseed rape varieties or food/feed products containing them: Ms8, Rf3, and Ms8 × Rf3.

These oilseed rape varieties cannot be grown in the EU, and any of these products – except food/food ingredients – sent to the EU must be labelled "not for cultivation". There are no safety or nutritional concerns associated with consuming these GM oilseed rapes.

Timeline

This Decision applies for a period of 10 years.
