

Renewed authorisations: genetically modified maize MON 87427, oilseed rape MON 88302, and soyabean MON 87708

What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has renewed the authorisations of genetically modified maize MON 87427, oilseed rape MON 88302, and soyabean MON 87708. This allows these GM maize, and products containing them, to continue to be placed on the EU market. However, cultivation of these crops in the EU remains prohibited. The renewed authorisations are based on favourable scientific opinions by the European Food Safety Authority.

Timeline

This authorisation is valid for a period of 10 years from 18 December 2025.
