



# Representative prices for poultrymeat imports from Brazil

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2025/2232</u> as regards fixing representative prices in the poultrymeat and egg sectors and for egg albumin.

### What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has increased the cost, insurance, and freight (CIF) representative prices of certain frozen poultrymeat from Brazil, to take account of price variations in the country of production.

### Timeline

The revised representative prices apply from 29 October 2025.
