Rice tariff quotas

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) <u>2024/2652</u> with regard to the management of certain tariff quotas in the rice sector, the adjustment of cheese export tariff quotas for the United States and an update of the technical specifications for the IMA1 certificates for the import of dairy products from New Zealand

What is changing and why?

The EU has amended its management of the rice quotas listed in Table 1. It has introduced limits to the quantity of rice that can be imported based on an operator's imports from the previous 2 years.

Timeline

The new rules will apply from 23 November 2026.
