## Template for fishery products dispatched from countries other than flag States

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) <u>2025/453</u> supplementing Regulation 1005/2008 by establishing a template for the document referred to in Article 14

## What is changing and why?

The European Union (EU) has introduced a uniform template for the information that must be provided when fishery products are imported into the EU by transiting through a country other than the flag State.

The new template ensures that the information required for the correct functioning of the EU's digital information system for catch certification (<u>CATCH</u>) is clear and consistent.

## Actions

From 10 January 2026 a new information template must be used for fishery products that transit through countries other than the flag States without any processing or other physical alteration

## Timeline

The new template must be used from 10 January 2026.
