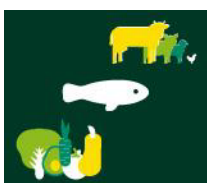

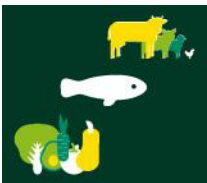
EU clarifies criteria for placing organic products on a high-risk list. Applies from **26 December 2025**

- Additional quota for [Auricularia polytricha mushrooms](#) in 2026 to meet domestic needs – applies from **1 January 2026**
